SPRING BREAK!

The purpose of this game is to educate people about the dangers of plastic in the ocean. The game is called "Spring Break" because the "players" in this game will be college students on spring break that roll dice to move around the board trying to keep as much plastic out of the ocean as possible. The player who littered the least and correctly answered ocean-related trivia will be the winner.

How to Play:

(2 players and 1 reader)

Player 1 rolls the dice.

Whichever number the dice lands on is how many spaces Player 1 moves.

The squares on the game board will have different prompts. Ex) "Litter, move back two spaces".

Player 2 rolls. Same as above.

Some squares have a Trivia prompt. Reader will ask the player the question. If they get it right they can advance 3 spaces and subtract 2 litter points if any.

Each litter station is labeled with a point value.

Whichever player makes it around the board first with the lowest number of litter points wins.
